

## DSM 5 Survey Summary:


KDADS sent out a DSM 5 survey to determine what has been implemented within agencies and organizations in preparation for the DSM 5. There were 207 responses which were primarily from SUD and CMHC; there were also responses from PRTF, Foster Care and Other. CDDO's and Early Childhood providers were included but there were no responses.

### Data from Survey:


- 78% started to assess the impact of the DSM 5 on their business;
- 56% started to create a business plan for implementation;
- 56% already started to assess the impact and create a business plan for changes;
- 73% developed a DSM 5 training plan for their staff;
- 64% already started educating staff on DSM 5;
- 50% felt that they will be ready for implementation of the DSM 5 by January 2015.

Response to Questions showed that their main concerns were the availability of training for staff, electronic medical records (EMR) barriers/vendor being ready by January...will the system support both DSM-IV and DSM 5 at the same time; biggest challenge is the cross walk and the transitions to DSM 5 and ICD-9 and then again when ICD 10 is ready ...to many transitions; DSM 5 and ICD 10 do not map well together....."They say they do; but when you place them side-by-side they do not"


### Question 1: Provider Type




**Question 2: Has your organization started to assess the impact of DSM 5 coding changes on your business? (Reponses: 162 Yes; 45 No)**



**Question 3: Has your organization started creating a business plan for implementing the DSM-5 coding changes? (Responses: 134 Yes; 71 No)**




**Question 4: When do you anticipate starting to assess the impact and creating a business plan for these changes? (Responses 108 Yes: 86 No)**
