Dear KanCare I/DD Program Participants,

You are getting this letter because you receive services under the Intellectual and Developmental Disability (I/DD) Program. This letter provides you with an update about your I/DD services.

The plan to include your home- and community-based long-term services and supports (HCBS) in your KanCare health plan on January 1, 2014 has been delayed.

You will not begin receiving your home- and community-based services and supports (HCBS) through your Managed Care plan on January 1, 2014. The State of Kansas is actively working with the federal government to set another date for your HCBS services to be included in KanCare.

In January, nothing will change. You will continue to receive the same home- and community-based services and supports (HCBS) from the same providers. These services may include:

- Assistive Services
- Medical Alert-rental
- Overnight Respite
- Residential Supports
- Specialized Medical Care
- Supportive Home Care
- Day Supports
- Financial Management Services
- Personal Assistant Services
- Sleep Cycle Support
- Supported Employment
- Wellness Monitoring

You can still access your services through the Community Developmental Disability Organization (CDDO). You will keep your targeted case manager (TCM) and service providers.

If you have questions, you can always call your targeted case manager, community service providers, CDDOs, or your KanCare MCO care coordinator.
