

Medicare is a federal health insurance program that covers:

- More than 35 million individuals ages 65 and older
- More than 6 million individuals younger than age 65 years with disabilities
- Individuals with End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)

Medicare Part A* is hospital insurance that covers:

- Inpatient hospital care
- Qualified short-term stay in skilled nursing facilities
- Home health care
- Hospice care

*Part A is premium-free for most individuals

Medicare Part B* is medical insurance that covers:

- Doctor's office visits
- Outpatient hospital care
- Lab tests
- Certain medical equipment and supplies

*Most individuals will pay a monthly premium for Part B

Medicare Advantage Plans (Part C)

- Combine Part A and Part B services (i.e., HMO, PPO, PFFS, etc.)
- Many of these plans also offer prescription drug coverage
- Many types of plans are available

Medicare Part D* Prescription Drug Coverage:

- Insurance that covers both generic and brand-name prescriptions
- Coverage is provided through private insurance companies
 *Many individuals will pay a monthly premium for Part D

Medicare Supplement Insurance (Medigap):

 Private health insurance that helps pay beneficaries' share of costs in Original Medicare

Medicare Savings Program (MSP):

 Helps pay Medicare premiums, deductibles, co-pays for individuals with limited income and resources

Part D Extra Help:

- Helps pay for premiums, deductibles and prescription drug costs
- Income eligibility requirement
