Wraparound Facilitation Training Closing Waiver Services

Waiver Rules

- The child and the family should know from the start of waiver services that the plan is for the child to eventually exit from the waiver.
- Concluding waiver services is a decision made by the wraparound team.
- As time to exit approaches, the child and the family shall be informed and included in the process as they are in all aspects of wraparound.
- Termination criteria will be established that lead to closing the waiver.
- There is a specific procedure and specific forms for terminating the HCBS waivers that must be followed and filed.
- The family can appeal the decision through an appeal procedure.
- In addition to the family, your supervisor, the wraparound team, the business office and others who have had a stake in the process should be notified as to the date that services for the child have or will end.

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
