## **Safety Tips**

## Here are some helpful hints to assist you in staying safe in the field:

- 1. Clarify role and relationship(s) with clients; maintain ethical boundaries
- Give clients source(s) for emergency and after-hours service(s) but do not include home phone numbers
- Have clear agenda and time frame discuss with client before meeting
- 4. Let others know your itinerary
- 5. Obtain clarity about who lives in the home, and their relationship with each other
- 6. Dual relationships in small communities can be difficult to avoid
- 7. Assess environmental safety (e.g., neighborhood, remoteness, loose animals)
- 8. Dress appropriately for (or appropriate to) the family, the activity and the setting
- 9. Leave purse and confidential case file materials in trunk of car
- 10. Observe potential dangers within the home (e.g., firearms, drug paraphernalia)
- 11. Locate exits from the home and position yourself accordingly
- 12. Be aware of potential health hazards (blood borne pathogens)
- 13. Identify back-up for client(s) when away from the agency
- 14. Use supervisory assistance to assess potential safety risks, preventive measures, or need for termination
